

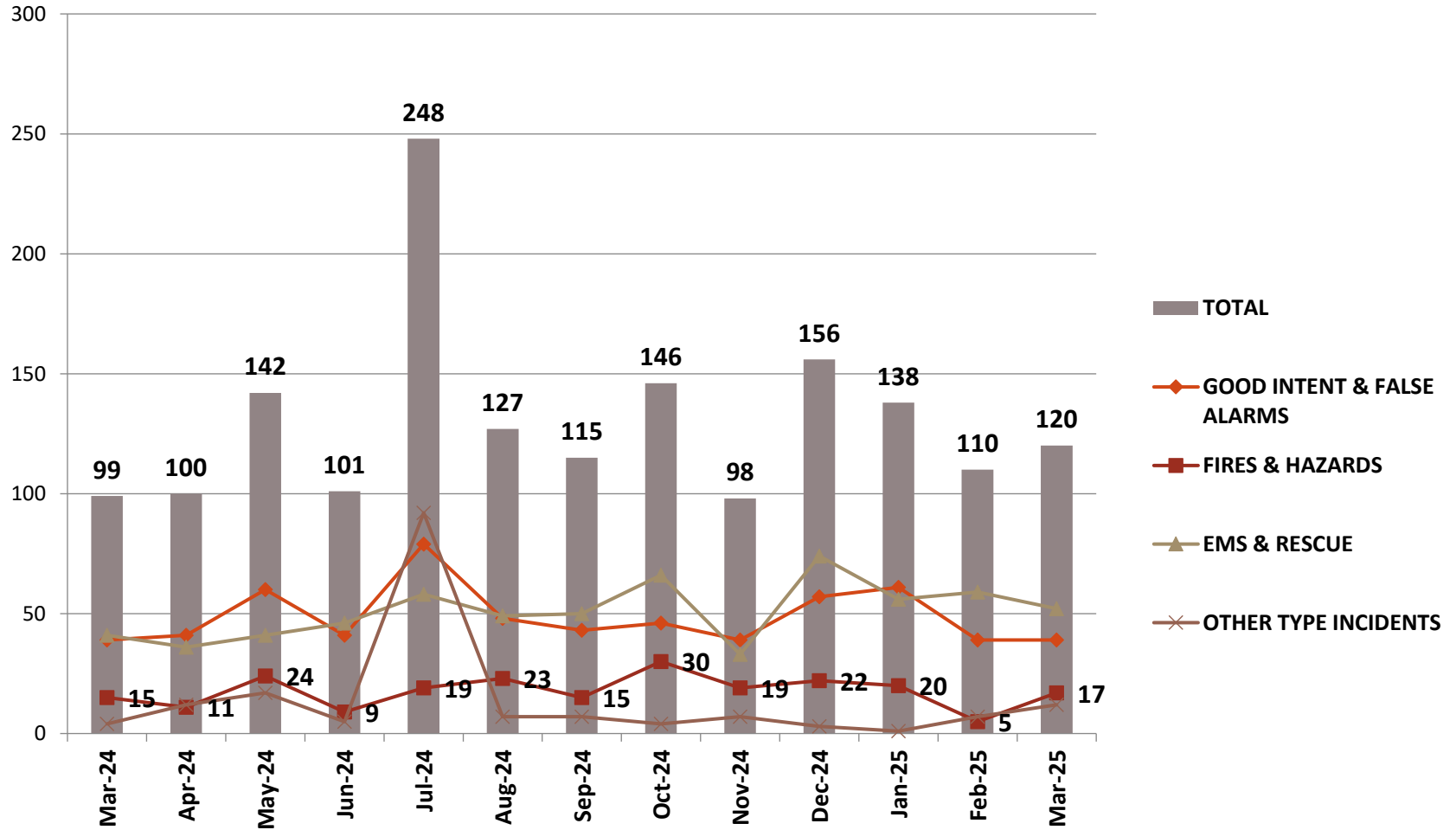

Count of Total Incidents & Exposures



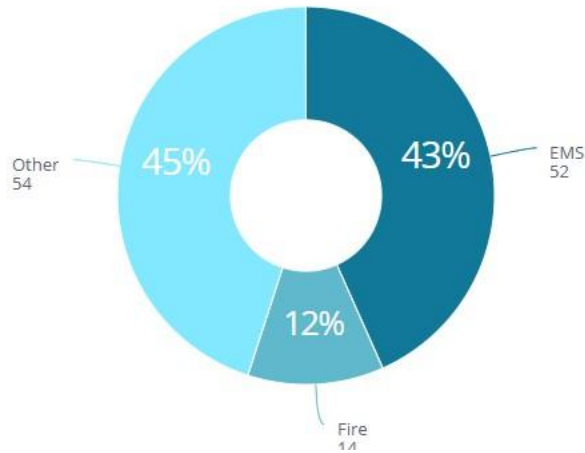

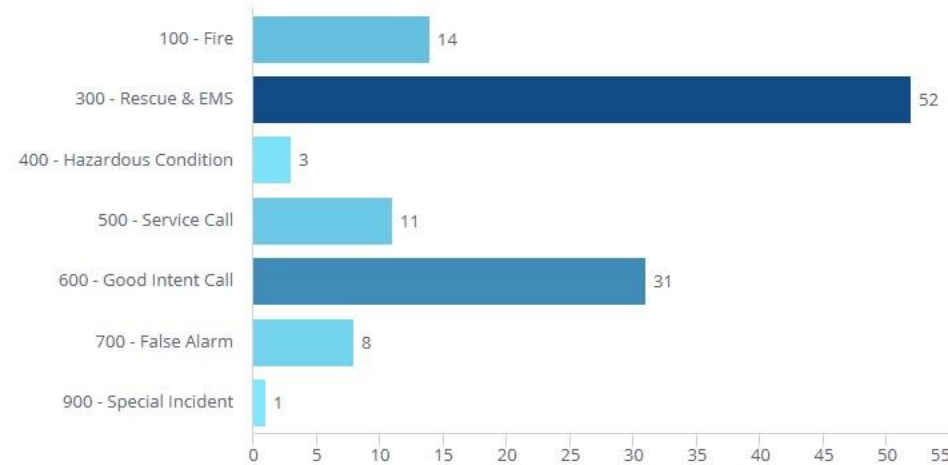

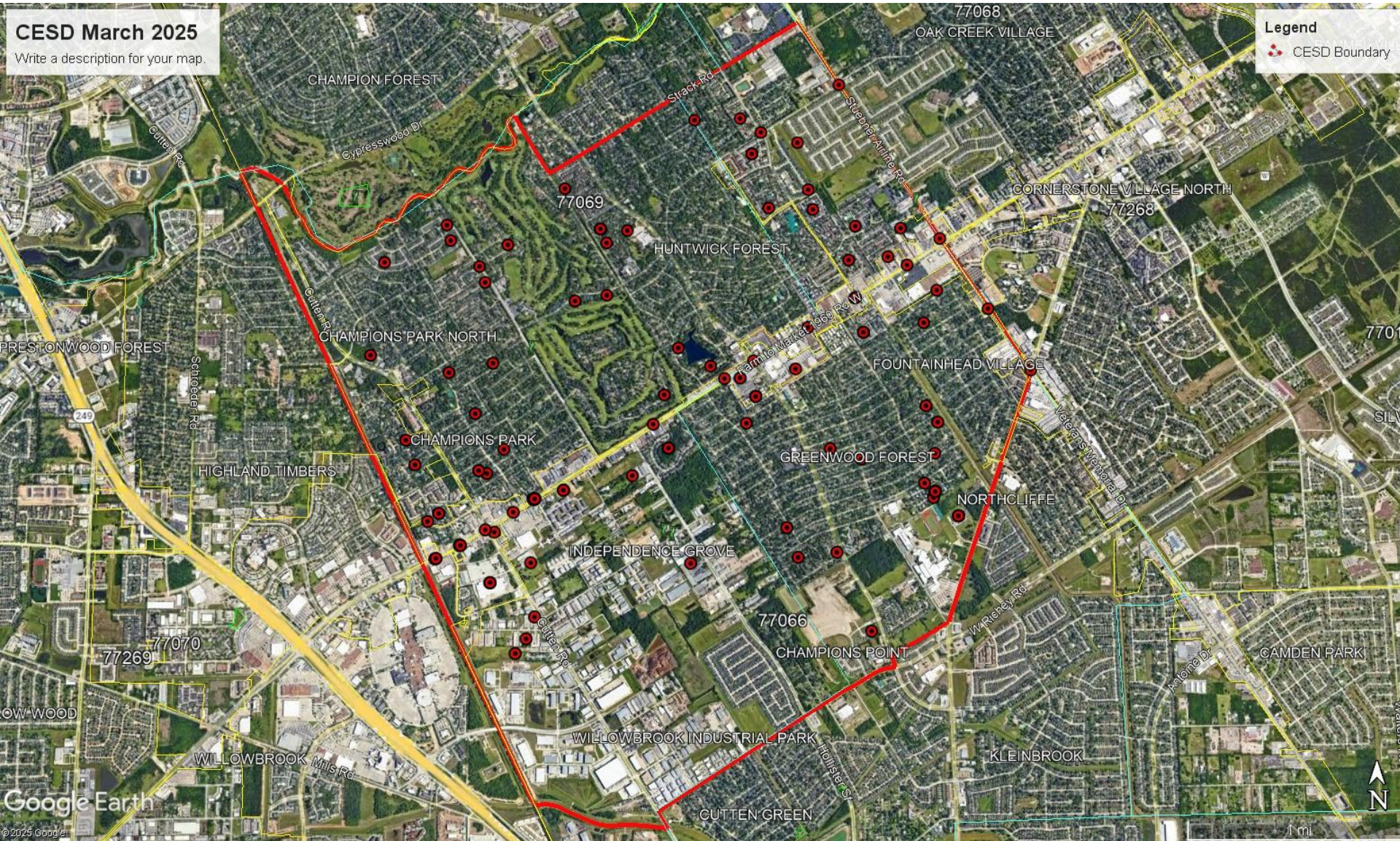
