

PUBLIC MEETING NOTICE

HARRIS COUNTY EMERGENCY SERVICES DISTRICT NO. 29

Notice is hereby given that **Harris County Emergency Services District No. 29** will hold a public meeting on **August 6, 2026**, at **4:00 p.m.**, at **Fire Station 11** located at **12730 Champion Forest Drive, Houston, Texas 77066**.

The District will consider and act upon the following matters:

1. Call meeting to order, roll call and establish a quorum.
2. Join together in the Pledge of Allegiance.
3. To receive public comment.
4. To receive the District's 2025 Audit Report from McCall Gibson, and to discuss and take action related to the same.
5. To review, discuss and take action regarding amendments to the 2026 District budget.
6. To review, discuss and propose the District's 2027 Budget.
This is an item to begin the Budget adoption process for the upcoming FY 2027. The District acknowledges the requirement of Government Code §551.043(c)(2) to prepare a taxpayer impact statement when reviewing and adopting budgets. However, the budget and tax rate have not yet been proposed and information with which to create the statement is unavailable. Therefore, no Taxpayer Impact Statement is included.
7. To review, discuss and propose the District's 2026 Tax Rate.
8. To schedule a public hearing regarding the District's 2026 tax rate and the date of the meeting to adopt.
9. To review and take action on matters relating to an election to be held on November 3, 2026.
10. To review, discuss and take action regarding any District financial institution matters, including but not limited to the execution of any necessary documents and resolutions for establishing District accounts and account signatories.
11. To receive a report from Better Bookkeepers, Inc., the District's bookkeeper, and take action on the Treasurer's Report.
12. To pay or authorize District bills and fund transfers required for operational expenses, payroll expenses and capital expenses, including any additional transactions, reversals, and/or ACH transfers.
13. To review, discuss and take action on submittals received from the District Commissioners seeking compensation as permitted by Texas Health & Safety Code §775.038 (a-1).
14. To approve the District meeting minutes of prior meeting(s).
15. To receive, discuss and take action on the Department's Fire Operations Report presented by Chief Dan Shelor.
16. To receive, discuss and take action on the Professional & Community Services report.
17. To review and take action on approval of expenses related to upcoming training classes, course materials, equipment and related expenditures to be incurred by the District.

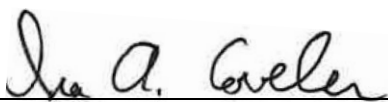
18. To review, discuss and act on District personnel matters including compensation, benefits, scheduling, training, retention, hiring and/or termination of District employees.
19. To review, discuss and take action regarding adoption and amendment of District policies and standard operating guidelines.
20. To review, discuss and take action on needed improvements or repairs to the District's station, related facilities, apparatus, vehicles or equipment.
21. Review, discuss and take action on submittals by the Department of thirty (30) day advance request(s) for necessary purchases related to the provision of emergency services.
22. To review, discuss and take action for the sale or disposal of surplus and/or salvage property pursuant to Texas Health and Safety Code §775.0735.
23. To discuss any new items that need to be on the agenda for the subsequent District meetings and to review the date for the next regular monthly meeting currently scheduled for September 3, 2026.
24. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.071 to consult with legal counsel regarding matters which require confidentiality under the Texas Disciplinary Rules of Professional Conduct of the State Bar of Texas.
25. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.072 to deliberate regarding real estate matters.
26. To meet in Closed Session pursuant to Government Code §551.074 to discuss personnel matters.
27. To reconvene in open session to review, discuss and take action on any real estate or personnel matters.
28. To review, discuss and take action regarding District government affairs.
29. Adjournment.
